### **Letter From The Pastor**

#### October 2023

As I write this the second Presidential candidate debate for the upcoming 2024 election has yet to happen. But based on what I've seen from both political parties, I don't doubt it will be more talking past each other than a debate.

This style of discussion has spilled over from Presidential debates to everyday life. Conversation skills including listening atrophied due to the necessity of limited social contact during the pandemic. Why is this important? Because how can we love our neighbors as we would be loved if we can't even talk and listen to each other.?

I shared in a sermon a few weeks about a scene from the TV show "Ted Lasso" that reflects the problem with this. In it Ted talks about how people usually underestimate him. One day he realized that it wasn't about who he was. It was that the others weren't curious about learning about him. Instead of asking him questions, they prejudged. (For those who you who haven't seen it, search online for it – the kicker in it is worth it even if you've never watched the show.) And of course Jesus was curious, asking people questions, listening to them, and seeing them for who they were, not how others labeled them.

So this month I'm offering a sermon series "I've Been Meaning to Ask you..." Through scripture passages we'll be looking at four questions. First "...where are you from?"- which is more than about your hometown. Second "...where does it hurt?" Next, "...what do you need?". Then finally, "...where do we go from here?" And for St. Johns and Hope joint "Fifth Sunday" service at the end of the month, we'll have a "creative" worship service to tie this all together.

The writers of the resources for this series describe why they decided to create it: "We started by asking ourselves questions: "How can we listen to one another?

### **Letter From The Pastor**

How do we find connection despite distance? How do we create space for compassionate dialogue and for seeking holy in one another? We landed on our leading question, "I've been meaning to ask…" because it conveys intentionality, warmth, curiosity, and consideration. In essence, this question also implies … "I've been thinking about you, and I've been wanting to check in… You've been on my mind… I haven't known how to have this conversation, but I'm getting started with a question." (T)he main objective of this series (is)to cultivate courageous conversations—and to keep having them, even if we need to pause."

For smaller communities like Fountain City and Cochrane, it may seem like "everyone knows everyone." Yet the pandemic and the spillover of political ideological divisions at times may still stretch the ability to fully talk and listen to each other. At the very least, reflecting on this may help individuals feel comfortable listening or know that they are heard, even if disagreement remains. At the very best, it can spill over into our world so that there are less divisive, judgmental conversations, and more relationship building, reconciling, and healing ones taking place.

# **Feeding C-FC Families**

#### The "Backpack Program" Is Now "Feeding C-FC Families"

The "Backpack program" for C-FC school families is being restarted as "Feeding C-FC Families". Kayla Engel began the "Backpack Program" as an FAA project to provide breakfast and lunch for school kids on days that they wouldn't receive breakfast and lunch at school. Mom Kalene Engel and Grandmother Bev Engel then took on responsibility for the program when Kayla went off to college. However the program paused during the pandemic.

While appreciative, the families who participated in the "Backpack Program" gave feedback that their students having an extra backpack each week was cumbersome, as well as made it easy for other students to identify who was taking part in the program. So with Kalene's help, the program occurs monthly, and is distributed at the Milton Town Hall. So far 17 families have signed up through the school. Monthly we will provide food for families for weekends and holidays to cover for the lack of school breakfast and lunches. In addition, "Feeding C-FC Families" will supplement the families normal food supply. Currently we need volunteers to provide this vital service. #### 1) On The 1st Wednesday Of The Month:

The truck with the food order for that month from "Feed My People" needs to be unloaded at Milton Town Hall, then brought into the Town Hall to store in the designated spots. Sometimes this will coincide with the delivery for the Food Shelf. Other times the Food Shelf may not need order that month, but the "Feeding C-FC Families" will still get a delivery.

# **Feeding C-FC Families**

#### 2) On The Following Tuesday: (Usually The 2nd Tuesday Of The Month)

- 1:00-2:00pm: Set out the food for packing There will be a set "menu" that everyone receives.
- 2:00-3:00pm: Pack the food in paper grocery bags for each family.
- 3:00-5:30pm: Be available for families to come pickup their bags.
- Possibly delivery drivers for after 3:00pm (when the bags are finished) to deliver to any families that cannot come to pick theirs up. This will be offered only when it is impossible for the family to pick up their food.

#### 3) For The Short Term...

Kalene and Pastor Deb are handling administrative tasks, such as food ordering, contacting families monthly, and reporting to Feed My Families the statistics from each month. However both have schedules that preclude doing this on an ongoing basis, and so would love will a volunteer to take over these tasks.

This is not intended as a replacement for our Food Shelf, but as a supplement and bridge. The brochure for the Food Shelf will be placed in each bag in case families aren't aware that St. John's Church has one, or that they can pick their own items from a shopping list. The hope is that they would consider using the Food Shelf, especially for long-term needs. However, some people might not be able to come during operating hours, don't want to 'bother' someone for an appointment, and/or go into a church. Feeding C-FC Families would continue to fill that gap. If you would like to volunteer for these or future dates, please contact Pastor Deb.




