Letter From The Pastor

November 2023

How did it get to be November already? Thanksgiving is coming up soon, and then it will be time for all the preparations for Christmas. (Of course the stores have had Christmas items since the beginning of October.) Already the church calendar is starting to fill up.

Here are a few of the happenings going on here over the next month or so.

First:

The Women's Guild Fall Bazaar is on Saturday, November 4 from 1:00pm to 3:00pm There will be baked goods to buy, gift baskets to take a chance on, and coffee and refreshments available to have while you browse or sit to catch up with people you haven't seen in a while. (Thank you to Hope United Church for their donation of a dog themed basket for the raffle.)

Second:

The Deacons are asking us to focus for the month of November the Deacons on the spiritual practice of stewardship - which is about more than what you give to the church. It is not only about how we care for our finances, but also our time, our energy, our relationships, and even Creation itself. 




